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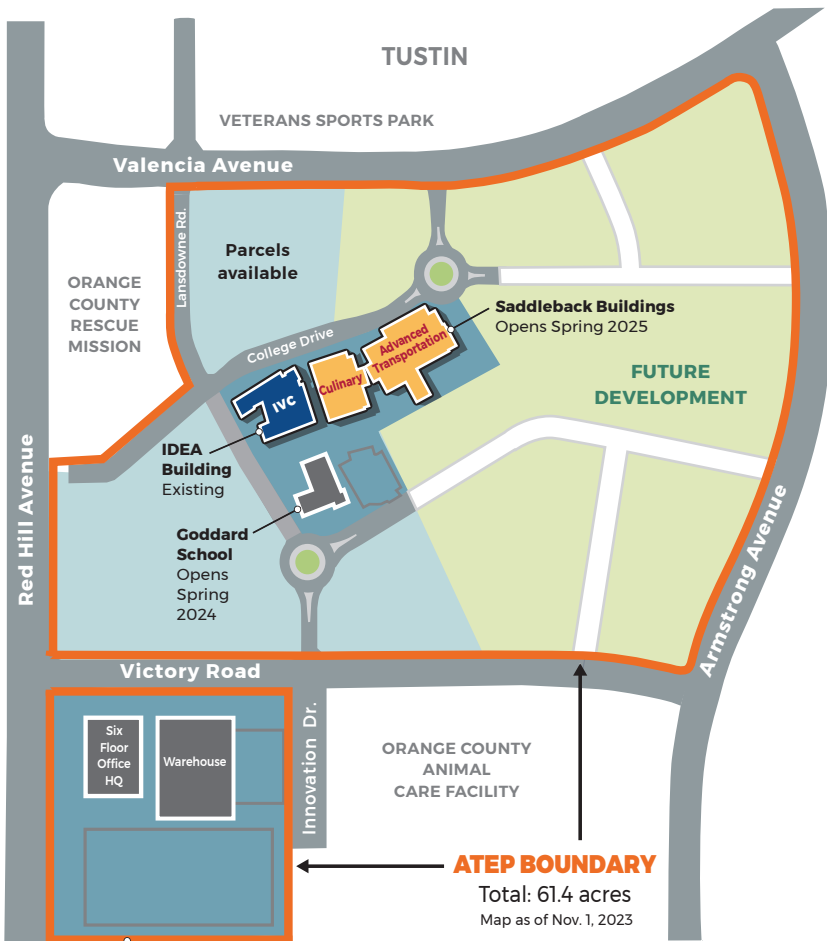
come together to enjoy shared interests in sporting and entertainment events, club meetings, and making connections with other students.

ATEP in Tustin

ATEP is a 61.4 acre developing campus in Tustin that is dedicated to workforce training. In addition to both colleges having instructional buildings at ATEP, the district also leases parcels to educational and commercial companies who then provide internships and work programs to students. This unique public-private partnership is designed to provide students with real-world work experience while pursuing their educational goals.

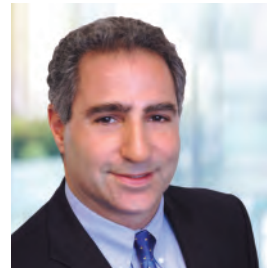

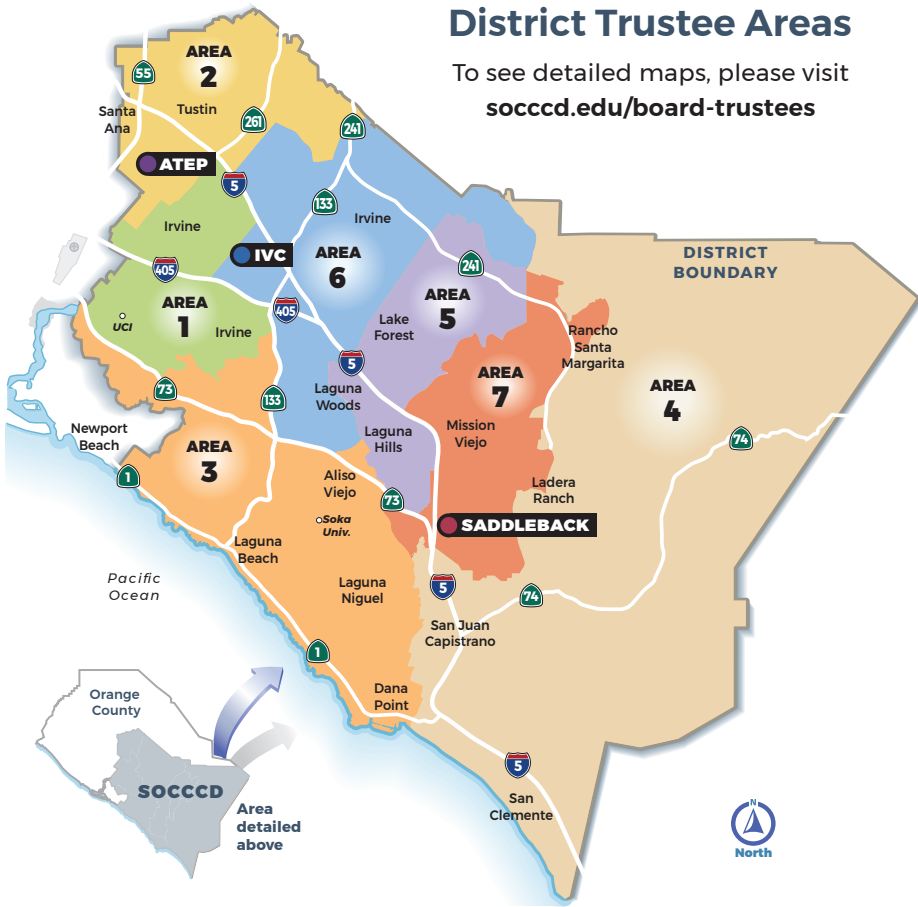
