Greetings Staff and Faculty:

In a message sent on [July 22](#), I shared with you that through discussions with the Board, classes would continue to remain online during the fall semester and presumptively in the spring as well. In working with the Board of Trustees, they confirmed that it would be most prudent to extend the teleworking status until December 31, 2020.

A decision about what to do related to the spring semester was made on Monday, September 21 during the regularly scheduled Board meeting, during which the Board of Trustees affirmed the administration's recommendation that the majority of classes and services will remain online through the 2021 spring semester.

Because the needs of the students, and the health and safety of students, employees, and the community, guide our decisions for operations throughout the District, the teleworking status will also remain in effect for the majority of employees through the spring semester until **May 31, 2021**.

Please remain in contact with your direct supervisor regarding work assignments, schedules, and work location. For staff and faculty that may need to come into the offices to conduct their work, please review the [return to work guidelines](#) and confirm your review of the guidelines with your supervisor.

Please remain healthy, remember to register to vote, and participate in the opportunity we are provided as citizens to exercise our right to vote by November 3.
