The Chancellor shall establish regulations to ensure implementation of Student Success and Support Program services that comply with the current laws and regulations. The colleges shall provide students, utilizing a full range of support services, accessible and equitable opportunities for a quality education, support for completion of their educational pathway, and attainment of their educational objectives.
