On Monday, October 28, 2024 the South Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees met for a regularly scheduled meeting. The following are highlights from the meeting held at 6:30 p.m. in the Ronald Reagan Board Room.

The meeting was presided by President Timothy Jemal and invocation led by Timothy Jemal Inmon. The pledge of allegiance was led by Trustee Marcia Milchiker.

6.1 – Resolutions

[Resolution In Support of Proposition 2: Kindergarten Through Grade 12 Schools and Local Community College Public Education Facilities, Modernization, Repair, and Safety Bond Act of 2024.](#)

On November 5, 2024, Californians will have the opportunity to vote on Proposition 2, the Public Education Facilities Bond Measure. This initiative seeks to issue \$10 billion in bonds, with \$8.5 billion earmarked for upgrading elementary and secondary educational facilities and \$1.5 billion dedicated to community college improvements.

Proposition 2 will modernize local schools and community colleges, enhancing science, engineering, career technical, and vocational education classrooms, labs, and learning technologies. This investment will provide students with advanced job training, technical knowledge, and specialized skills, better preparing them for high-paying careers.

11.4 SOCCCD: California School Employees Association (CSEA) Chapter 586 – Tentative Agreements.

BACKGROUND

The collective bargaining agreement between South Orange County Community College District (District) and the Classified School Employees Association (CSEA) expired on June 30, 2024. The District and CSEA negotiators have reached tentative agreements for Article 3 – CSEA Rights, Article 5 – Evaluations, Article 7 – Hours and Overtime, Article 8 – Pay and Allowances, Article 9 – Health and Welfare Benefits, Article 10 – Holidays, Article 11 – Vacations, Article 12 – Leaves, Article 13 – Transfers and Reassignments, Article 14 – Grievances, Article 16 – Safety, Article 17 – Layoff and Reemployment Procedure, Article 21 – Negotiations, and Article 22 – Duration for a new 3-year successor agreement. The term of the successor agreement will be July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2027.

STATUS

California Government Code Section 3547 et seq. requires the disclosure of costs associated with a collective bargaining agreement. The cumulative costs of the agreement with CSEA for the three-year period, as displayed in Exhibit B, are estimated to be \$15,924,099, including benefits.

RECOMMENDATION

The Chancellor recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the Tentative Agreements (Exhibit A) between the District and CSEA, subject to ratification by CSEA membership.

11.5 SOCCCD: Faculty Association FA Master Agreement

BACKGROUND

The collective bargaining agreement between South Orange County Community College District (District) and the Faculty Association (FA) expired on June 30, 2024. The District and FA have reached an agreement for the period of July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2027. (Exhibits A and B)

STATUS

California Government Code Section 3547 et seq. requires the disclosure of costs associated with a collective bargaining agreement. The estimated costs of the agreement with FA for the three-year period, from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027, are estimated to be \$24,431,879

RECOMMENDATION

The Chancellor recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the agreement with FA for a three-year successor agreement, subject to ratification by FA membership.
