Key to this process is a review of the Board's time horizon for investment, short-term liquidity needs and attitudes, as well as the capacity to accept investment risk as measured through the expected rate of return of the Board. Amendments to the Trust Agreement, Investment Policy Statement and the Participation Agreement will be offered to allow Adopting Entities to select the model portfolio of their choice.
